Camp Krem Yosemite is a non-profit organization serving children, teens, and adults with a wide range of developmental disabilities. We are seeking hardworking Kitchen Assistants to work at our camp in Ahwahnee, CA!

Mission: Camping Unlimited provides out-of-home respite to caregivers of children and adults with developmental disabilities. We seek to provide relief from the daily demands of care and supervision, while fostering independence, nurturing responsibility, developing competence, and building lifelong friendships. We provide a warm and supportive atmosphere of planned permissiveness that encourages community, recreation, education, fun, and adventure.

Position Details: Seasonal (summer camp) position to provide nutritious meals to campers and staff. Compensation depends on experience and desire to have room and board provided or live-offsite.

Reports to: Program Director

Compensation: \$1,060 per 10-day session and \$530 per 5-day session for live-in position, with room and board provided, or \$16/hr for live-out position.

Job Summary: Help the Head Cook and Assistant Cook in the daily operations of food service at camp including food preparation and kitchen sanitation. Ensure you are following strict adherence to hygiene and food service protocols.

Essential Job Functions:

- Assist in the daily operations of the camp food service:
 - Assist in the preparation of food as the menu indicates including washing and peeling;
 - Set up food, supplies, and utensils for dining hall distribution;
 - Store food and leftovers at proper temperature;
 - Set up an adequate area for the disposal of trays, silverware, trash, glasses, recycling, etc;
 - Maintain, stock, clean, and prepare beverages as needed in the dining room area;
 - Oversee the sweeping and mopping of the dining hall on a daily basis;
 - Inventory and refill any materials needed in the operation of the dining room.
- Assist in routine sanitation of the kitchen and related equipment:
 - Clean and maintain all food-preparation and storage areas;
 - Wash all dishes, serving and preparation equipment, and utensils according to regulated washing methods and temperatures;
 - Reduce waste, reuse items, and recycle as indicated through camp's procedures;
 - Oversee the cleanliness of tables, benches, floors, to ensure the dining area is clean and ready for the following meal.

Other Job Duties:

- Interact appropriately with campers, including modeling appropriate behavior and behaving with enthusiasm, patience, and a sense of humor;
- Maintain effective communication with administrative camp staff, other staff, and campers, regardless of ability, race, creed, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or expression;
- Abide by all camp policies and procedures.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Ability to lift and carry 50-75 pounds including unloading food, carry trays of dishes, lifting supplies and equipment as needed;
- Visual ability to identify and respond to environmental hazards;
- Physical ability to operate kitchen equipment according to safe recommended methods;
- Determine cleanliness of dishes, food surfaces, and kitchen area;
- Able to stand for up to two hours at a time;
- Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid. Must be able to assist campers in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury);



- Up to date COVID-19 vaccination status and willingness to undergo regular COVID testing for the safety of our campers and staff.

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age or older;
- Knowledge of food preparation and serving, storage of food, and dishwashing procedures is preferred;
- Desire and ability to work with children and adults with disabilities;
- Undergo full criminal background check, and reference checks;
- Possess ServSafe certification, or be willing to obtain prior to starting work.
