Camp Krem Yosemite is a non-profit organization serving children, teens, and adults with a wide range of developmental disabilities. We are seeking hardworking, dedicated, caring Nurse Assistants to work at our camp in Ahwahnee, CA!

Mission: Camping Unlimited provides out-of-home respite to caregivers of children and adults with developmental disabilities. We seek to provide relief from the daily demands of care and supervision, while fostering independence, nurturing responsibility, developing competence, and building lifelong friendships. We provide a warm and supportive atmosphere of planned permissiveness that encourages community, recreation, education, fun, and adventure.

Position Details: Seasonal (summer camp), live-in position.

Reports to: Program Director

Compensation: Room and board provided, as well as a stipend of \$1,150 per 10-day session and \$575 per 5-day session.

Dates: May 21st - August 14th. Option to extend contract to August 22nd for Session Eight.

Job Summary: Nurse Assistants support the Registered Nurses in the care, health and safety, and general well-being of the campers and staff during camp sessions.

Essential Job Functions:

- Assist in providing health care and first aid services to meet the needs of camp staff and campers;
- Assist with daily medication management and administration;
- Help supervise and care for people admitted to the Health Center for care;
- Monitor and assist in maintaining health and safety practices while working in other areas throughout camp;
- Work with other staff to minimize/eliminate health and safety risks;
- Assist the nurse with preparation for first day medication set-up including rosters, labels, and phone calls;
- Assist the nurse with follow-up phone calls and making doctor's appointments.

Other Job Duties:



- Assist the Camp Nurse with the organization, cleanliness, and maintenance of the Health Center and health care supplies;
- May be assigned additional duties by the nurse or Program Director as needed;
- Complete and submit all paperwork as required within designated time frames;
- Communicate and interact effectively with fellow staff members, administrative staff and campers, regardless of ability, race, creed, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or expression;
- Abide by all camp policies and procedures.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Able to read and write in English;
- Able to lift 50-75 pounds;
- Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid. Must be able to assist campers in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury);
- Physical ability to stand for long periods, bend, stoop, walk long distances, hike;
- Ability to perform job responsibilities during daylight and nighttime hours;
- Be willing to live in a camp setting and work irregular hours with limited or simple equipment and facilities' and with daily exposure to the sun, heat, and animals (bugs).

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old;
- Have enthusiasm and ability to work with children and adults with developmental disabilities in a rustic outdoor setting;
- Current First Aid and CPR certification, or willingness to obtain;
- Be adaptable, enthusiastic, compassionate, possess good judgment, and willing to learn;
- Undergo full criminal background check, and reference checks;
- Up to date COVID-19 vaccination status and willingness to undergo regular COVID testing for the safety of our campers and staff.
